

Terms & Conditions

1. Eligibility:

- The voucher system is available to youths born between 1st January 2004 and 31st December 2009.
- This initiative targets youths born between 2004 and 2009, **as long as they have not already benefited from the scheme this year**, offering them six months of free gym membership.
- Applicants must be either **Maltese, Gozitans** or those who possess a **Maltese Residence Card from EU or EEA/Swiss Countries**. Youths must provide proof of their ID card upon request.
- Each eligible applicant may apply for one voucher only.

2. Application Process:

- Applications must be submitted through the official government or designated website within the specified application period.
- All required details must be provided.
- Incomplete or falsified applications will be automatically disqualified.

3. Voucher Use and Redemption:

- Vouchers can be redeemed at participating gyms across Malta and Gozo.
- The voucher is strictly personal and non-transferable.
- The voucher may only be used for gym memberships or access fees and cannot be exchanged for cash or other services.
- Each gym may have its own terms regarding membership activation, and applicants must comply with their policies.
- Once voucher is redeemed, applicants **cannot** change gyms.

4. Validity and Expiry:

- The voucher is valid for a period of six (6) months from the date of issuance.
- Expired vouchers will not be extended, reissued, or refunded.

5. Responsibilities and Liability:

- Participants are responsible for ensuring they are medically fit to engage in gym activities. The organizers of the voucher system shall not be liable for any injury or health-related issues that arise from the use of the voucher.
- Participating gyms are responsible for ensuring a safe and adequate training environment.

6. Fraud and Misuse:

- Any attempt to sell, transfer, duplicate, or misuse the voucher will result in its cancellation and possible disqualification from future schemes.
- Any fraudulent claims may be subject to legal action.

7. Changes and Termination:

- The issuing authority reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate the voucher system at any time without prior notice.
- Any changes will be communicated through official channels.

8. Data Protection:

- Personal data provided during the application process will be used solely for the administration of the voucher system and will be handled in accordance with applicable data protection laws.
- Data will not be shared with third parties except as necessary for voucher administration.

9. Contact Information:

- For any queries or assistance regarding the voucher system, applicants may contact the designated helpdesk or email the relevant department.
